

SR3 TECHNICAL BULLETIN No: 1 DISABLING ALARM FUNCTION

It has been reported that some vending machines are being free vended by sticking an object up the coin reject chute. The SR3 is detecting the object being inserted into the validator and is outputting an Alarm signal which is a combination of all of the Accept lines turned on together.

On some machines this Alarm signal is seen as a valid coin being accepted and a credit is issued. To disable the Alarm signal on these machines you will need to do the following:

Switch off the power to the SR3.

Switch on the power to the SR3. Press the reject lever within 20 seconds. **(Mode 10 can be accessed at any time).** The LED will flash GREEN. Switch off the power to the SR3. Set ALL the DIL switches to the OFF position. Switch on the power to the SR3. The alarm is now OFF.

In future the Alarm function will be disabled by default on all SR3 unless specified.
